

COOKIES POLICY

Please be informed that the Administrator of the data - the Don Bosco Makululu Foundation registered in Warsaw at 30 lok. 302 Mikolaja Kopernika Street, National Court Register: 0001103865; VAT Number: 5253003497; Company ID: 528661738 uses cookies that belong to the Data Administrator and third parties. Detailed information about the use of cookies are presented in this cookies policy.

1. Cookies are small pieces of computer data, especially text files, stored in the user's end device, that are used while the user is browsing a website. These files allow for identifying the user's device and properly displaying a web page, tailored to fit their individual needs. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they originate from, the expiry date on the end device and an unique number.
